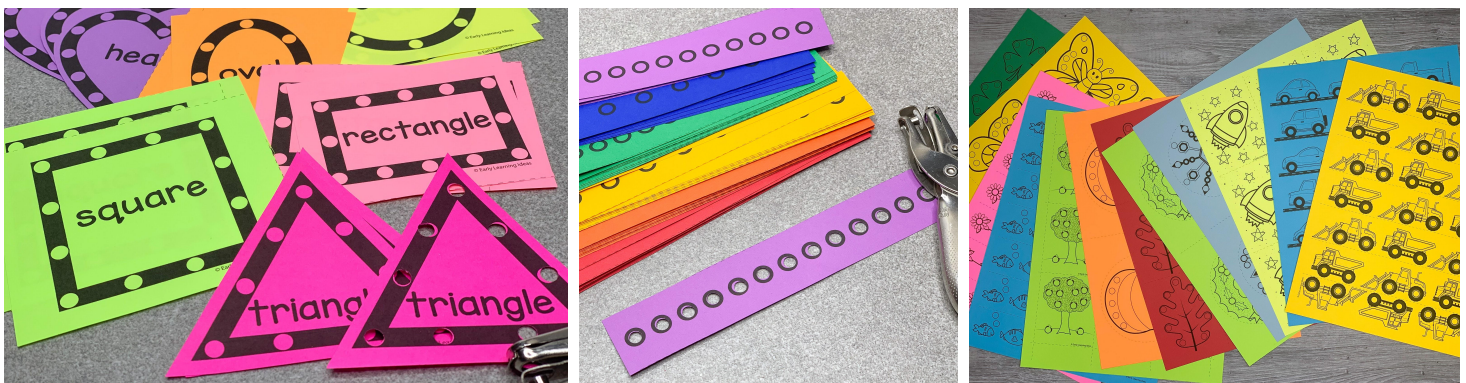

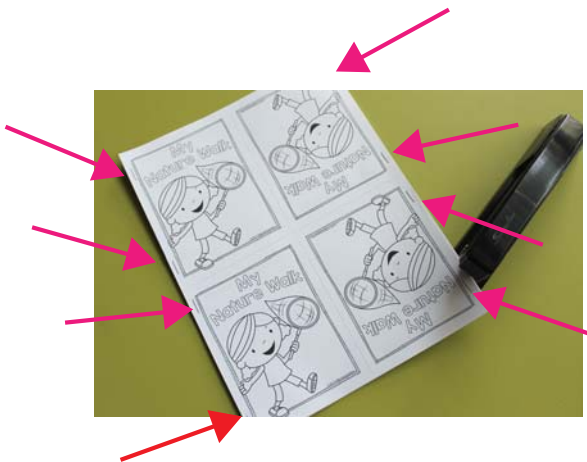

LITTLE BOOK ASSEMBLY



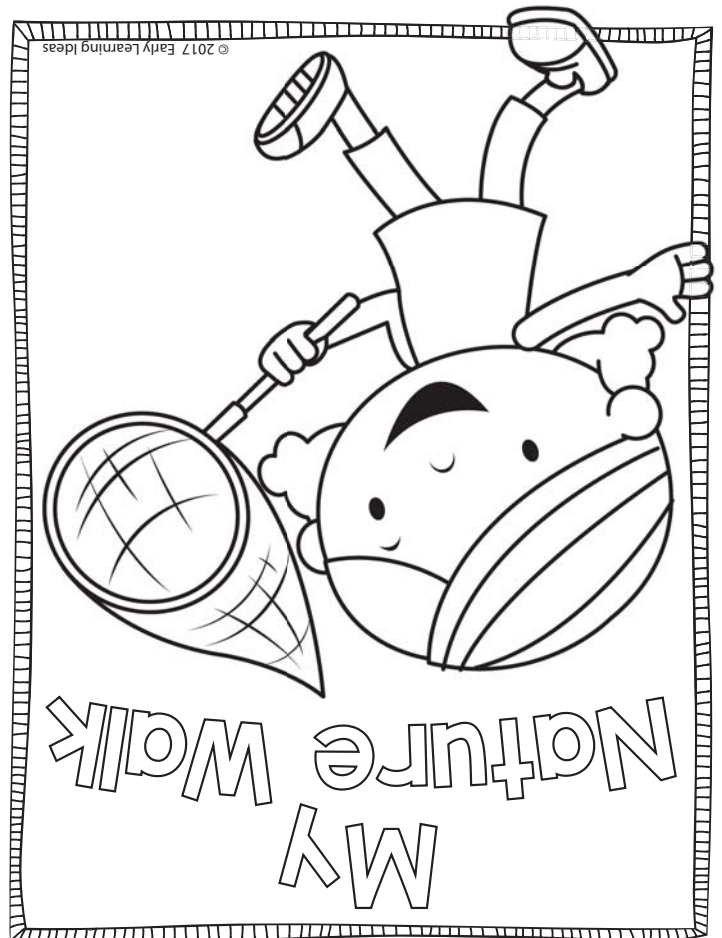
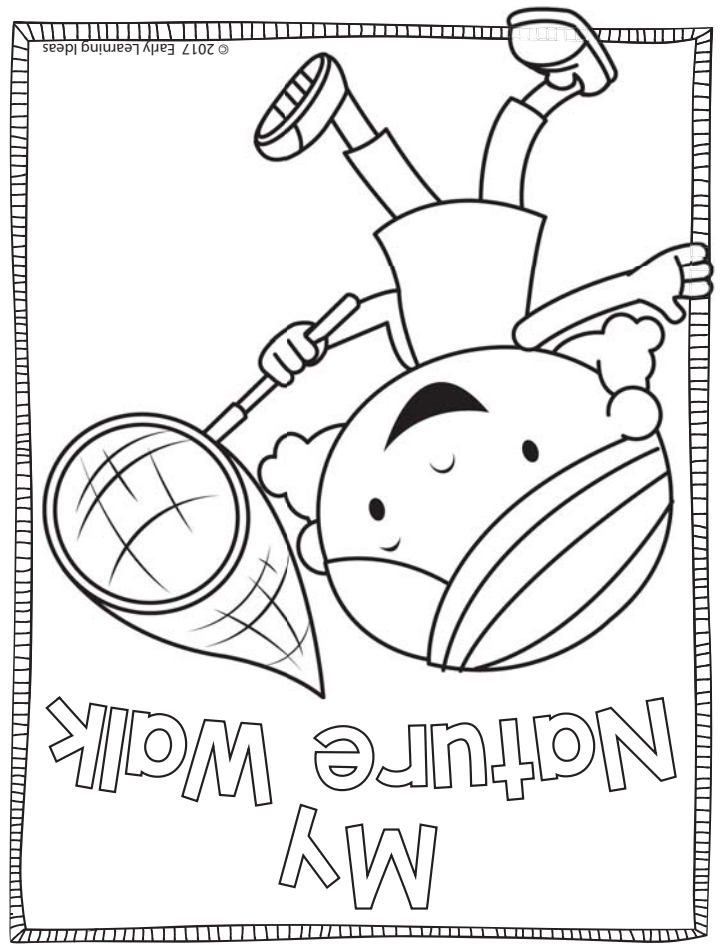
1. Print a set of nature walk book pages. Please note that one set of nature walk books will create four little books for your children. Place one set of number book pages in a neat pile.
